Who Should Attend?

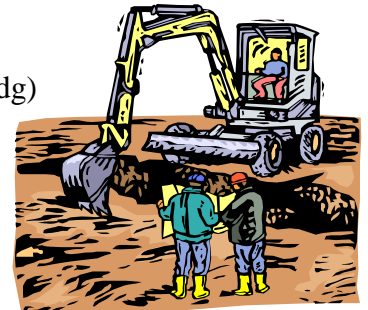
Any construction business or town that plans on constructing a project **that disturbs more than one acre of land should attend**. The NEW DEC Stormwater Permit Requirement, beginning May 1, 2010, mandates that all construction site contractors and subcontractors must have a least **one trained individual from their company on their construction sites on a daily basis** who is responsible for implementation of erosion controls and stormwater management. **These individuals must have completed THIS 4 hour training class** on the principles and practices of erosion and sediment control and stormwater management. Training is not required for CPESC, L.A., and P.E. certified persons.
